



Saw Operators - Door Department (SOPHD1021)

Main Function of the Job:

To operate double head mitre saw to cut wood for doorframe preparation. To provide assistance in door department cutting, notching, packing, doorframe assembly and door furniture fitting.

Key Responsibilities:

- Accurate measurement and cutting to size
- Cutting architrave to suit frames, to include PVC, Timber & MDF Architraves
- Use of hand tools router/ drills
- Correct fitting of door furniture, namely handles, cylinders, kick plates, acoustic seals
- To make glazing bead cassettes- cut bead to size, fit intumescent, Hoffman joints
- Pallets secure and correct materials used for bracing
- Picking of correct accessories- architraves, closers etc.
